### Travel to Braga:

**By Air:** Participants should take flights to Oporto Airport. Daily flights are available to and from most large European cities. All participants arriving or departing by air are advised to travel by taxi between the airport and Braga, as no regular direct coaches or trains are available. The taxi fare is around 60 Euro.

**By Train:** Participants entering Portugal from Spain should travel to Porto and take the connection Porto – Braga.

**By Car:** For participants travelling by car through Spain it is suggested to enter Portugal at Vilar-Formoso. Starting here, the IP5 dual carriage-way leads to Aveiro, but at Albergaria (176 Km) participants should enter the A1 motorway and go to north in the direction of Porto (58 Km), cross the city of Porto, using the Freixo bridge, without leaving the motorway and exit at the junction for the A3 motorway to Braga (49 Km).

### Accommodation:
